1. Design and make your own Viking shield.
2. In role as a Viking, write a diary describing your voyage to Britain.
3. Draw and label a diagram of a Viking longship.

Design your own menu for a Viking feast. You could even try making and tasting some Viking style food.

8. Why was King Alfred called Alfred the Great? Create an information poster to explain why.
