We know that the first recordings of art were Cave Art. Design a piece of cave art using materials of your choice. i.e. paint, chalk, crayon.	Research animals that lived in Britain during the Stone Age. Draw, label and write facts about at least 3 of them. 	Create a Stone Age feast, thinking carefully about the food and drink that would be on offer for these hunter-gatherers. Write a 'menu' for this feast.
Research roundhouses then draw a cross-section to show what they were like inside.
