School Development Plan 2024 – 2025

In November 2019, Ofsted reported on the following two school improvement targets. As a school, we are required to keep these in focus until a re-inspection.

1. KS2 pupils do not have enough opportunities to listen to adults read to them or to select from the school's wide range of library books. This limits their potential to develop their enjoyment of reading. Leaders need to ensure that they give pupils more opportunities to listen to and read a wide variety of high-quality texts.
2. Leaders have recently revised subject plans. They must continue to check that sequences of teaching enable pupils to deepen their knowledge and skills so that they progress well through the curriculum.

Focus for 2024-2025 to move Thrupp School forward:

1. Developing a hub understanding and approach to metacognition
2. Developing middle leaders – 1: Enabling middle leaders to develop assessment activities to ensure pupils know and remember more. 2. Ensuring teaching strategies are used to support learning.
3. To increase our percentage of pupils achieving expected level at KS1 and KS2 in writing and provide opportunities for pupils to excel and achieve greater depth within writing.
4. Ensure consistency in our approach to maths and develop strategies to support our more able pupils to meet their potential.
5. Develop a nurture space to ensure that we have a quiet and engaging space for ELSA work and nurture groups through school.
6. Provide all of our Reception, Year 1 and 2 children in both Kestrels and Hawks access to high quality continuous provision.
